Update on Existing Shared Path Upgrade - Uhrs Point Reserve, Rhodes

In March 2023, we consulted with the community regarding a proposed upgrade of the existing Shared Path between Llewellyn Street and Uhrs Point Reserve carpark, Rhodes.

We have reviewed the feedback received and updated the plans to address the concerns and ideas raised. Only two trees are now planned to be removed on the southern side of Concord Road, compared to the four previously identified. These two trees will be replaced by planting four new trees within Uhrs Point Reserve as outlined in the attached plan next year, as part of Council's broader tree planting works.


The updated plan also includes a wider ramp to assist in transitioning cyclists smoothly between the Shared Path and Llewellyn Street. To discourage drivers from obstructing access, we are planning to install hatched line-marking adjacent to the driveway and ramp on the carpark outside the 1st Yaralla Sea Scout Group.

We are currently finalising the detailed designs and anticipate construction will commence in late-2023. Further notification will be sent before commencement about how the works will be managed.
