Cabarita Park Lighting upgrade and Summer House Maintenance

Dear Resident

As part of our ongoing commitment to the community, Council is pleased to announce the upcoming upgrade of lighting along the western foreshore path at Cabarita Park, as well as the maintenance of the two summer house pavilions. The works are scheduled to take place from April to June 2025.

Council is committed to providing a safe environment for all members of our community and this work is part of a larger program to improve lighting across the City of Canada Bay's public spaces.

During this time, there will be interruptions to lighting along the path, and we advise visitors to take an alternative path if lighting is insufficient. Otherwise, please exercise caution if using the path. Thank you for your patience and cooperation during this time.

The lighting upgrade works will involve the installation of new light poles to improve visibility along the path. Please refer to the next page to see the location of the works.

During the summer house maintenance works, the pavilions will not be available for use, nearby shelters will remain available during this time.
