Council is working with key stakeholders to develop a **Disability Inclusion Action Plan for 2017-2021**.

Why does council need a Disability Inclusion Action Plan (DIAP)?



In August 2014, the State Government passed a new act called the Disability Inclusion Act 2014. The Act requires all Councils in NSW to develop a Disability Inclusion Action Plan.

People with disability nominated four key areas as being of primary importance in creating an inclusive community.

These are:

- Developing positive community attitudes and behaviours
- Creating liveable communities
- Supporting access to meaningful employment
- Improving access to services through better systems and processes

What will the Plan do?

The plan will guide Council towards developing more inclusive environments for people with disability. It will include practical actions to support engagement and access for people with disability in the community.

The Plan will be integrated with Council's Delivery Program so that the inclusion of people with a disability is considered at all levels of planning for facilities, services, programs and activities.
