Dear Resident,

Greenlees Park – Parking Upgrades

To help improve parking availability and pedestrian access alongside Greenlees Park, Council will soon commence parking and shared pathway upgrades to Greenlees Avenue, Concord.

The project includes:

- The installation of 28 rear-to-kerb parking spaces, to replace and provide more parking spaces than the existing kerbside parking
- Construction of a wider shared path for pedestrians and cyclists, replacing the existing path to improve safety and accessibility

Construction is scheduled to commence at the end of September and is expected to be completed by mid of November, weather permitting. Works will generally take place from 7am–5pm, Monday–Friday, with occasional Saturday works if required.

For safety reasons, some areas of the park and footpath will be temporarily closed during construction. Signage and fencing will be in place, and we kindly ask for your cooperation in avoiding restricted areas.

Thank you for your patience as we deliver these important parking and access improvements.
