Concord to Bay Run (East – West) Regional Cycleway

As part of our ongoing commitment to delivering better local pedestrian and cycling connections, the City of Canada Bay is pleased to advise that construction will soon commence on the Lyons Road West segment of the Concord to Bay Run (East-West) Regional Cycleway.

This project includes:

- A separated cycleway along Lyons Road West
- Improved lighting and upgrade of the existing bus stops
- A new pedestrian and cycling crossing near Marceau Drive
- A new pedestrian and cycling crossing near Regatta Road
- Drainage Improvement works

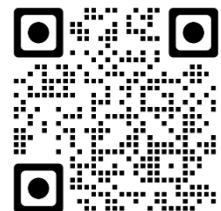
These changes will improve accessibility throughout the City of Canada Bay and improve active transport and pedestrian connections throughout our area. Safety and amenity will be increased for both pedestrians, cyclists and motorists alike. This project is proudly funded by the NSW Government in association with the City of Canada Bay.

Please find attached a plan of works for your information.

Construction is scheduled to commence mid-October 2025, with works expected to be complete by the end of April 2026. Works will take place Monday to Friday between 7am and 5pm, with occasional Saturday works if required. Traffic will be managed through a traffic management plan, and onsite personnel when required.
