**REPORT**

On Australia Day this year Superintendent David Johnson was awarded the Australian Police Medal in recognition of his outstanding services to the Police Force.

Since joining the New South Wales Police Force as a Constable at the Petersham Police Station in 1985 Superintendent Johnson has had an accomplished career.

Over the past three decades he served across Australia, from the Australian Bureau of Criminal Intelligence in Canberra to the NSW State Intelligence Group to numerous Task Force investigations including Task Force Air into Ivan Milat, Task Force Colo into paedophile syndicates and the investigation review into the murder of Sydney underworld figure Angelo Duros.

From 2012 he was Commander of the Ashfield Local Area Command and in 2018 he was appointed as the inaugural Burwood Police Area Commander.

At the City of Canada Bay we feel honoured to have Superintendent Johnson as the Commander of the Burwood Police Area Command and we are grateful for the assistance he provides to Council in so many ways beyond his ordinary duties.

In recognition of the honour that has been bestowed upon him and in gratitude for the service he has devoted to our Local Government Area I would like to thank and commend Superintendent Johnson on behalf of the City of Canada Bay.
