The project includes:

- Reconstruction of a section of the existing concrete footpath
- Reconstruction of the existing concrete roundabout

A plan of the works is attached to this letter for your reference.

Construction is expected to commence in August 2025, and the project will take approximately six weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Works will be carried out Monday to Friday from 7am to 5pm and Saturdays from 8am to 3pm on Saturday. Traffic control measures will be in place throughout the duration of the project to ensure the safety of both workers and the community. Access to properties will be maintained at all times. The contractor will provide advance notice of any disruption and take steps to minimise any inconvenience to residents and businesses.
