As part of our commitment to improving local infrastructure, we are pleased to announce that we will be undertaking footpath replacement works on Queen Street.

This work is part of our Accessibility Program that represents an investment of \$1million for the maintenance of Pedestrian Access upgrades in the 2021/2022 financial year.


These works are planned to start in late February and scheduled for completion in early March 2022, weather permitting. Our contractors will advise you in writing before commencing work, including any information about temporary parking restrictions that may be required.

Generally, works will be carried out from Monday to Friday during hours of 7am-5pm. However, there may be some instances that may require work outside of these hours.
