Howley Park Upgrade – Commencement Update

Dear resident,

Council has adjusted the construction timetable for the Howley Park Upgrade to avoid disruption to residents and visitors over the busy Christmas and New Year period.

Construction is now scheduled to commence from mid-January 2026, weather permitting. Works will generally take place Monday–Friday from 7am–6pm and Saturdays from 8am–1pm, in line with the development consent and standard construction hours.

To improve parking availability, the temporary Works Zone signs at the end of Victoria Place have now been covered, re-enabling on-street parking for residents and visitors over the holiday period.

The covers will be removed, and the Works Zone will be re-established on 7 January, so the contractor can install temporary fencing and safely establish the site during the week commencing 12 January 2026.

These upgrades will deliver:

- Foreshore access to previously inaccessible areas
- Improvements to existing park spaces
- Upgrades to the existing streetscape and parking arrangements.

The Howley Park Upgrade is proudly funded by the NSW Government in partnership with the City of Canada Bay.

We appreciate your patience and understanding, particularly given the complexity of preparing for construction in such a constrained area.
