Pedestrian crossing upgrade – Tranmere Street, Drummoyne

As part of our commitment to upgrading pedestrian crossings and improving safety, we are pleased to advise that the pedestrian crossing on Tranmere Street outside of St Mark's Catholic Primary School will be upgraded. The works are being funded by the Federal Road Safety Stimulus (School Zones) Program.

These works are scheduled to commence in late July 2022, with completion expected by late August 2022, weather and site conditions permitting.

Our contractors will advise you in writing before commencing work, including information about any temporary parking changes that may be required.

Generally, works will be carried out between Monday to Friday from 7am to 5pm, however, there may be instances that will require work to be undertaken outside of these hours.

While most works will be undertaken outside of school drop-off and pick-up hours, a temporary pedestrian crossing and vehicle drop-off area will be in place to ensure safety.

We are working towards improving our local streets and thank you for your patience and cooperation during the works.
