Howley Park Upgrade – Drummoyne

Dear resident,

As part of our long-term vision to connect and revitalise the Howley Park Precinct, Council is pleased to advise that works will soon commence on the **Howley Park Upgrade** in Drummoyne. This project aligns with the Howley Park Masterplan, adopted by Council in December 2023.

These works will deliver:

- Foreshore access to previously inaccessible areas
- Improvements to existing park spaces, and
- Upgrades to the existing streetscape and parking arrangements.

Please find attached a map of the works for your information. These upgrades are proudly funded by the NSW Government in partnership with the City of Canada Bay.

Construction is scheduled to commence in late October 2025 and is expected to be completed by early March 2026, weather permitting.

Works will generally be carried out Monday–Friday from 7am–6pm and Saturdays from 8am–1pm. The contractor will provide advance notice of any disruptions, should this be required, and take steps to minimise inconvenience to the community.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation as we work to improve this valuable community space.
