Timbrell Park Precinct Update

As part of our commitment to improving our parks and open spaces, a number of upgrades are taking place or are planned for the Timbrell Park precinct in Five Dock. These works align with the Timbrell Park Masterplan adopted in August 2024 and include:

Street Parking and Regional Cycleway

Additional parking is being constructed along Henley Marine Drive in conjunction with the Regional Cycleway.

Stage 1 (Augusta Street to Timbrell Drive) will deliver 53 rear-to-kerb parking spaces and a new 3–3.5 metre-wide shared path connecting to the Bay Run. These works are expected to commence mid-May and expected to be completed by August.

Stage 2 will deliver a further 42 rear-to-kerb parking spaces, shared path extensions, and new pedestrian crossings. These works are scheduled to be completed in the next 6–9 months.

Works will generally occur Monday to Friday between 7am and 5pm, with occasional Saturday work if required. During construction, sections of the park and footpath will be temporarily closed. Signage and fencing will be in place to ensure public safety, and we ask for your cooperation in avoiding restricted areas. Nearby residents will be notified prior to works commencing.

Sportsfield Upgrade

The sportsfield upgrade is progressing well, with sporting infrastructure now in place and turf currently being laid. Subject to weather conditions, the fields are expected to reopen after the June long weekend.

Outdoor Fitness Equipment

Following community consultation late last year, Council is progressing plans for a new outdoor gym. A contractor has been appointed to undertake the detailed design, with construction anticipated to be completed in the next 6 months.

The LIVVing Room Project

This project involves the development of a new, accessible social enterprise space near Livvi's Place Playground designed to provide greater opportunities for community connection. It will also support people who face barriers to mainstream employment by helping them develop skills, gain meaningful work experience, and become valued members of the community.

Construction will be managed by Touched by Olivia. For more information about The LIVVing Room project visit touchedbyolivia.com.au/the-livving-room. Work will generally take place Monday to Friday between 7am and 5pm, with occasional Saturday work as required.
