Footpath construction - Links Avenue & Cumming Avenue, Concord

As part of our commitment to improving local infrastructure, we are pleased to advise that new footpath will be constructed, outside 131 Cumming Avenue, Concord. New pram ramps will also be constructed to improve access across Links Avenue.

This work is part of our Annual Accessibility Works program that represents an investment of \$382,000 for pedestrian access improvements in the 2022/2023 financial year.

Works are scheduled to commence in October with completion expected by mid-October 2022, weather permitting. Our contractors will advise you in writing before commencing work, including information about any temporary parking restrictions that may be required.

Generally, works will be carried out between Monday to Friday from 7am to 5pm; however, there may be instances that will require work to be undertaken outside of these hours.
