Pedestrian and vehicular improvements at the Gale Street, Brays Road and Mortlake Street intersection.

As part of our commitment to improving local infrastructure, Council is pleased to advise that works will be undertaken to improve pedestrian amenity and safety by upgrading the existing roundabout at the Gale Street, Brays Road and Mortlake Street intersection.

Works will include:

- Construction of new pedestrian facilities
- Improvements to existing traffic islands
- Installation of new speed cushions to reduce traffic speed
- · Relocation of the bus stop and
- Restoration and repairs to the existing infrastructure

The works are scheduled to commence in late April 2025, with completion expected by early June 2025, weather permitting.

The work will be planned to minimise impact on businesses and the community. Construction will take place in front of business premises at times, and Council's contractor will provide advance notice of any disruptions. We are working towards improving our local streets and thank you for your patience and cooperation during this time.


