Roadworks Notification – Heath Street, Five Dock

As part of our commitment to expanding our local bike network and providing a safe cycling environment for people of all ages and abilities, we are pleased to inform you that we are undertaking roadworks to Heath Street, Five Dock, as part of our new East-West Regional Cycleway.

These include:

- The construction of new pedestrian/cyclist refuges at the intersection of Henley Marine Drive and Heath Street
- The construction of a separate on road cycle lane for northbound, uphill cyclists on Heath Street, between First Avenue and Henley Marine Drive.

Works will commence in mid-September and are scheduled for completion by late October 2022, weather and site conditions permitting. Our contractors will advise you in writing before commencing work, including information about any temporary parking restrictions that may be required.

Generally, works will be carried out from Monday to Friday between 7am–5pm, however there may be some instances where work is required outside of these hours.

These works are part of our \$7 million East-West Regional Cycleway connecting Concord to the Bay Run, funded by the NSW Government through the Parramatta Road Urban Amenity Improvement Program. Visit bit.ly/concordtothebayrun to learn more.

Changes to your bin collection

Following the construction of the new on-road cycle lane, we ask that residents on the western side of Heath Street (between First Avenue and Henley Marine Drive) place their bins at the ends of the concrete islands on collection day, as outlined in the plan overleaf.

We ask that residents on the eastern side of Heath Street continue to place their bins on the nature strip directly behind the kerb for collection.

This will ensure the new on-road cycle lane remains clear and provide easy access for our waste collection contractor.

Please be reminded that bins should not be placed in the gutter. Should you have any queries regarding how to present your bin for collection, please contact Council's Resource Recovery Team on 9911 6555.

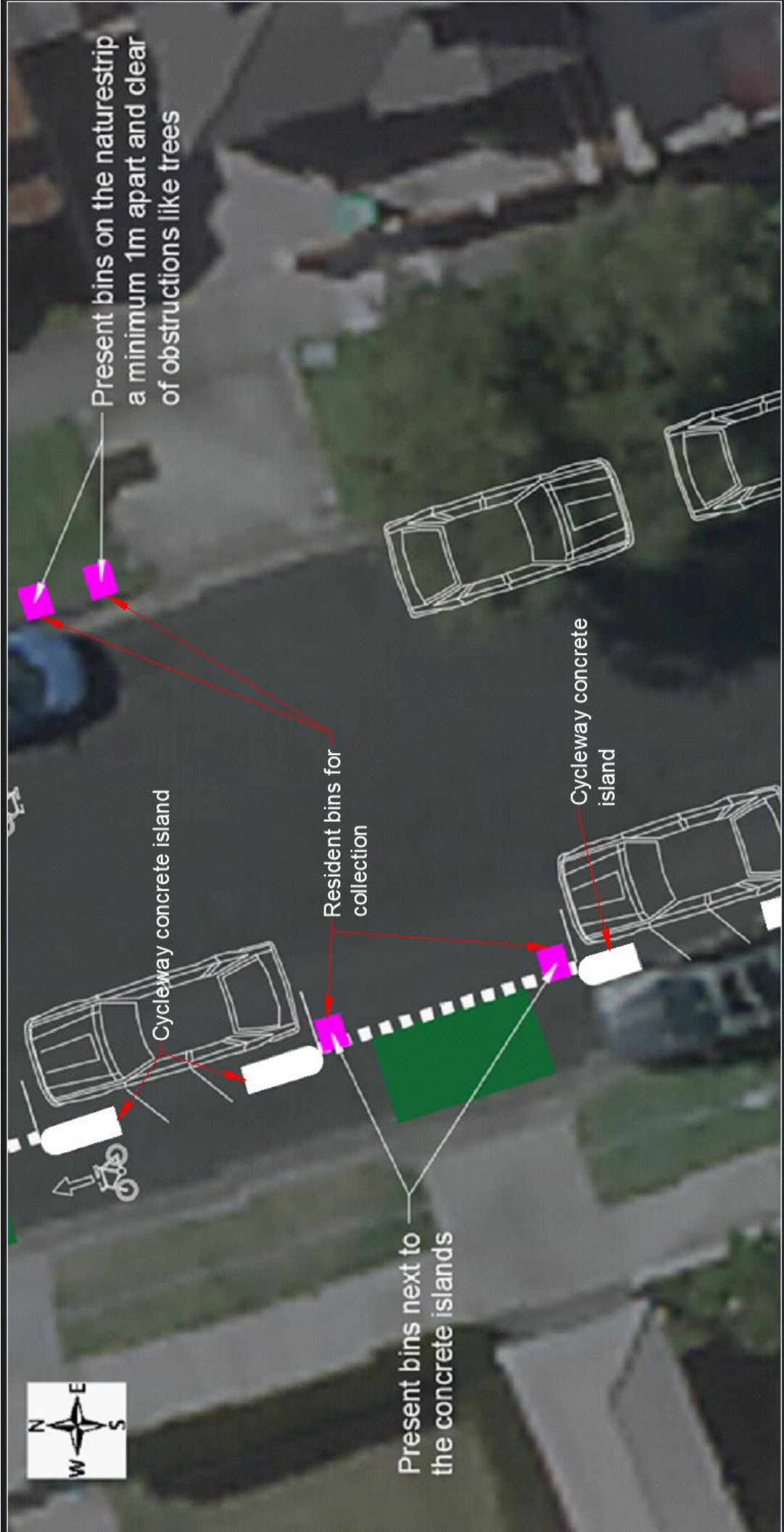
