



## Investigation work on Australia Avenue, Underwood Road and Homebush Bay Drive on/off ramps from Thursday 1 December 2022

The Australian and NSW governments are investing \$100 million to upgrade the intersection of Homebush Bay Drive, Australia Avenue and Underwood Road to ease congestion, increase safety, and improve travel times and connectivity to Homebush and Sydney Olympic Park for all road users.



To inform project planning, Transport for NSW will carry out service and investigation work on Australia Avenue, Underwood Road and Homebush Bay Drive on and off ramps between **Thursday 1 December 2022** and **Tuesday 28 February 2023**.



There will be **no work from Friday 23 December 2022 to Sunday 8 January 2023**.

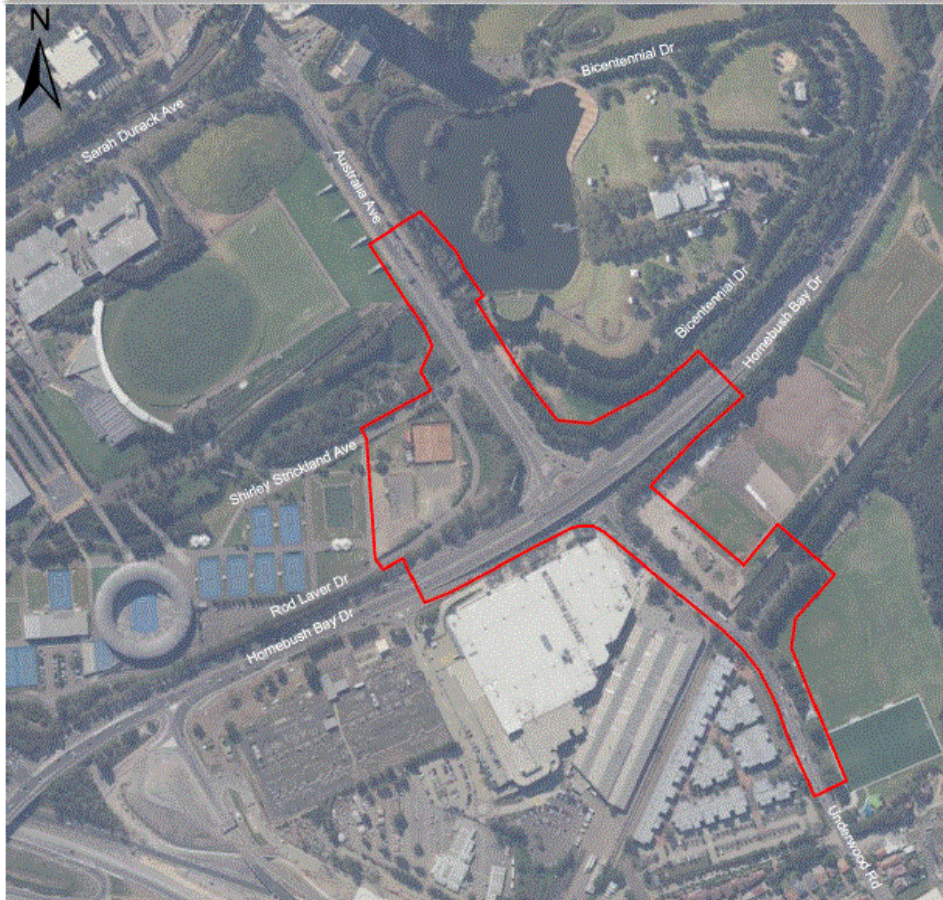


Work activities include locating above and below ground utilities, locating stormwater drainage structures, geotechnical investigations, and traffic, visual and contamination surveying.

### Our work schedule

We will be on site for up to **35 night shifts** and **10 day shifts** between **Thursday 1 December 2022** and **Tuesday 28 February 2023**, for utility, drainage and pavement investigations, and for geotechnical and surveying activities. None of these works will result in a full road closure. There may be intermittent lane closures only, and no requirements for detours.



Our **day work hours** will be between **7am and 6pm** from **Monday to Friday**. Our **night work hours** will be between **8pm and 5am** from **Sunday night to Friday night**.



We will not work on public holidays, and there will be no work from **Friday 23 December 2022** to **Sunday 8 January 2023**.

## How will the work affect you?

Some of our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers and motorists. The work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise noise impacts. This includes using noise blankets and utilising quieter equipment where we can, turning off equipment and vehicles when they are not in use, and completing the noisier tasks, such as potholing, by midnight.

## Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes at night to make sure the work zone is safe.
