



# Traffic light upgrades on Victoria Road and Edwin Street, Drummoyne from Monday 11 January

The NSW Government is carrying out this essential work as part of the NSW Safer Roads Program to improve safety for road users.


Transport for NSW will upgrade the traffic lights at the Victoria Road and Edwin Street intersection, Drummoyne from **Monday 11 January 2021.** 

The upgraded traffic lights will have turning arrows including a red arrow to help pedestrians cross the road safely by holding turning vehicles.

The upgrade will improve safety and provide consistent driving conditions at this intersection.

To carry out the work we will have to dig up the footpath to install new electrical pits and underground cables, and the road surface to install new electrical cables. When our work is complete, we will restore the road and footpath to existing conditions.

We notified the community in early November on working up to five nights per week. We received one piece of feedback about noise and have responded to the community member.

## Our work schedule

We will be on site for seven night shifts from Monday 11 January 2021 to Friday 5 February 2021, weather and work site conditions permitting.

Our night time work will be from **Sunday** to **Thursday** between **8pm** and **5am** the next day. We will not work on public holidays.

We will be working up to five nights per week.

# How will the work affect you?

Our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise traffic disruption and reduce safety risks to the workers and road users.

We will do everything we can to minimise construction noise including completing noisier tasks like jack hammering and saw cutting **by midnight.** 

# Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe for pedestrian, motorists and workers. Traffic controllers will be on site to direct motorists and pedestrians, including when the traffic lights have to be switched off.
